APUF-7 is a multi-stakeholder forum for sustainable urban development solutions.

The Forum is co-organised with Urbanice Malaysia, Government of Malaysia and UN-Habitat, and provides a unique platform to discuss and analyze the status, challenges and opportunities of the implementation of the New Urban Agenda, the Paris Agreement, Sendai Framework, Addis Ababa Action Framework and the 2030 Agenda in the region. APUF-7 will serve as the venue to launch The Future of Asia-Pacific Cities Report 2019 in partnership with the Asian Development Bank, the European Union, The Rockefeller Foundation, UNDP, UN-Habitat and Singapore's Centre for Liveable Cities.

It is expected that over 1000 participants will attend including ministers, mayors, civil society and private sector leaders.
